
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## NOTICE

THE WATUMULL FOUNDATION (INDIA) POST GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

1. There shall be a scholarship known as 'The Watumull Foundation (India) Post-Graduate Scholarship' to be awarded out of the annual income accruing from the endowment fund of Rs. 12,000/- endowed by Watumull Foundation (India) Dalestar, 1st Floor, 9-9A, Hughes Road, Bombay-36 W.B.
2. A Scholarship of Rs. 100/- p.m. tenable for 2 years of the duration of course shall be awarded to a poor and needy student who joins the 1st year of Post-Graduate Course in Physics/Chemistry/Botany/Zoology/Anthropology/Geology/Commerce of this University, provided the student concerned is a regular student of the University and had secured not less than 60% marks in the previous examination and whose parents income including his/her own income does not exceed Rs. 25,000/- per annum excluding permissible standard deductions.
3. The Scholarship for the award shall be announced every alternate year or after a gap of two years, as the case may be, through the Principals/Heads of the Colleges/Departments.
4. No student shall be eligible for this scholarship if he/she is in receipt of any scholarship or any other financial assistance, other than freeship, from any University/State Government/Private Body and the Central Government.
5. In case a scholar accepts any other scholarship or financial assistance from any other source, the total amount received from this endowment fund shall be refunded by him/her to the University from the date he/she accepts any other scholarship or financial assistance. The unutilized amount will be added to the corpus fund.
6. If it appears to the University at any time that a scholar is unable to show satisfactory progress or is found guilty towards his/her conduct or is irregular in attendance, he/she shall, after due warning in writing be reported by Head of the Department/Institution to the Academic Council, who may withdraw the Scholarship.
7. Each application for the scholarship, in the prescribed form obtainable from the office of the Registrar, must reach the Registrar, University of Delhi, Delhi-7, through the Principal/Head of the College/Departments by the date mentioned in the notification issued in this behalf, together with a certificate from the Principal/Head of the College/Department to the effect that the applicant is a poor, needy and deserving student for the award and that the income of his/her parent/guardian does not exceed Rs. 25,000/- per annum excluding permissible standard deductions.
8. The Scholarship amount shall be payable monthly by the Registrar, on a bill through the Principal/Head of the Institution who shall certify thereon that the scholar is in regular attendance, that his conduct is good and that his progress is satisfactory.
9. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendations of the Selection Committee constituted as follows:-
  1. The Dean, Faculty of Science (Chairman)
  2. The Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences
  3. The Heads of the concerned Departments.

**Guidelines to run "Dr. I.P. Mittal Scholarship"**

1. There shall be two scholarships to be known as "Dr. I.P. Mittal Scholarship" of the value of ₹ 32,500/- to be awarded every year to two students studying in M.Sc. (Chemistry), department of Chemistry, University of Delhi out of the annual income accrued from the endowment fund of ₹ 10,00,000/- (Ten Lacs) donated by Smt. Ved Mittal, Justice Gitta Mittal and Vandana Roy, address E-327, Greater Kailash – I, New Delhi – 110048.
2. The Scholarships shall be awarded to two meritorious students pursuing students in M.Sc. (Chemistry) on the basis of securing the highest makes in the M.Sc. (Chemistry) I semester examination.
3. The total value of both scholarships shall be 50% of the annual interest accrued from corpus on the income. Out of which 10% will be administrative cost.
4. 50% of the accrued interest will be added up to Endowment Fund each year.
5. No student shall be eligible for award of this scholarship if the scholar already holds a scholarship awarded by this University or any other University or the Central Government or any State Government or Private Body, other than freeship.
6. In case a student accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source the student shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account from the date she accepts the other Scholarship/Financial Assistance.
7. The scholarship shall be awarded by the University on the recommendation of a Department Selection Committee consisting of the following:
  - i. The Dean, Faculty of Science
  - ii. The Head, Department of Chemistry
  - iii. Two Senior Teachers of the department
8. The payment of the scholarship shall be released to the students through the Head of the Department on presentation of a bill along with a certificate to the effect that during period covered in bill the students were not in the receipt of any other scholarship/finance assistance from any other source.
9. The unutilized amount in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.

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1. There shall be two scholarships to be known as "*Surendra and Karen Gupta ARC Foundation*" to be awarded every year to two students studying in M.Sc. (Chemistry) II semester department of Chemistry, University of Delhi out of the annual income accrued from the endowment of ₹ 14,64,2,59/- (Fourteen Lakhs Sixty Four Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Nine Only) donated by Sh. Ajay Gupta, Flat 202 Aditya Greenfields Apartments, BP Raju Marg, Kondapur Hyderabad- 500084
2. The Scholarships shall be awarded to two meritorious students pursuing studies in M.Sc. (Chemistry) II semester on the basis of securing the highest marks in the M.Sc. (Chemistry) I semester examination.
3. The total Value of both scholarships shall be 50% of the annual interest accrued from corpus on the income. Out of which 10% will be administrative cost.
4. 50% of the accrued interest will be added up to Endowment Fund each year.
5. No student shall be eligible for award of this scholarship if the scholar already holds a scholarship awarded by this University or any other University or the Central Government or any State Government or Private Body, other than freship.
6. In case a student accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source the student shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account from the date she accepts the other Scholarship/Financial Assistance.
7. The Scholarship shall be awarded by the University on the recommendation of a Departmental Selection Committee consisting of the following:

8. The Payment of the scholarships shall be released to the students through the Head of the Department on presentation of a bill along with a certificate to the effect that during period covered in bill the students were not in the receipt of any other scholarship/finance assistance from any other source.

1. There shall be a one time Book Grant known as “Shri Jugal Kishore Jain & Smt. Kalawati Jain Memorial Book Grant” of the value of Rs.2000/- to be awarded out of the annual income accruing from the endowment fund of Rs. 40,000/- endowed by Prof. A.C. Jain, 209, Vaishali, Pitampura, Delhi-110088 in the memory of his parents.
2. The Book-Grant shall be awarded strictly by merit to a student of M.Sc.Chemistry (Final) year class offering Organic Chemistry as a special subject ~~and~~ who secures the highest marks in the first year of the M.Sc. examination among the students opting for Organic Chemistry.
3. No student shall be eligible for the award of this Book-Grant if he or she is already in receipt of scholarship awarded by the University of Delhi or any other University or the Central Government or any State Government or a Private Body other than a freeship or financial aid.
4. In case the awardee under this endowment is awarded any other scholarship or gets financial aid from any other source, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account from the date he/she was awarded any other scholarship or financial aid.
5. In case a scholar discontinues studies without valid reasons, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on account of the Book-Grant.
6. The payment of the Book-Grant amount shall be made to the scholar through the Head of the Department of Chemistry on presentation of a bill and a certificate to the effect that the awardee was not in receipt of any other scholarship/financial aid from any other source.
7. Any amount accruing as interest from the endowment and not spent shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
8. A report of the award of Book-Grant shall be furnished to the donor or a legal heir. The order of legal heir is (1) Smt. Vijaya Jain (2) Shri Vivek Jain (3) Shri Abhishek Jain.

**“PREMOJA CHAUDHURI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP”**

1. There shall be a scholarship known as “*Premoja Chaudhuri Memorial Scholarship\**” of the value of ` 200/- p.m. to be awarded out of the annual income accruing from the endowment fund of ` 25,000/- endowed by *Dr. M. Chaudhuri, a resident of 9-A, Nizamuddin West, Mathura Road, New Delhi*, in memory of her late *elder sister Premoja Chaudhuri*.
2. The Scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of marks-cum-means basis to a needy student whose parents income including his/her own income does not exceed to the amount from where it starts attracting income tax, and who joins the first-year of the M.Sc. (Chemistry) course of this University. The Selection Committee would be free to raise this limit if due to escalation in cost of living this limit needs to be raised upwards.
3. The Scholarship shall be tenable for a period of two years, renewable yearly on the basis of satisfactory performance of the awardee.
4. a. No student shall be eligible for the award of this scholarship if he already holds a scholarship awarded by Delhi University of any other University or the Central Government, or any State Government or Private Body, other than Freeship.  
b. In case any scholar accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, he shall be required to refund the amount received by him/on this account from the date he accepts the other scholarship/financial assistance.
5. If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the award that the scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been irregular in attendance, he shall, after the due warning, in writing, be reported by the Principal/Head of the Institution/Department to the Academic Council which may reduce, suspend or withdraw the Scholarship.
6. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendation of the Selection Committee constituted as follows:-
  1. The Dean, Faculty of Science (Chairman)
  2. The Head, Department of Chemistry
  3. One Professor of the Department of Chemistry to be nominated by the Head of the Department of Chemistry.

1. There shall be a Fellowship known as **"PROFESSOR A.C. JAIN FELLOWSHIP"** of the value of Rs.1000/- p.m. to be awarded out of the annual income accruing from the endowment fund of Rs. 3,00,000/- endowed by Prof. A.C. Jain former Professor of the Department of Chemistry, University of Delhi. r/o 209, Vaishali, Pitampura, New Delhi-110088.
2. The fellowship shall be awarded strictly by merit to a student of M.Sc. Chemistry (Final year) class offering Organic Chemistry as a special subject and has obtained highest marks in the first year of M.Sc. examinations among the students opting for Organic Chemistry.
3. The fellowship shall be tenable from July to April.
4. No student shall be eligible for the award of this Fellowship if he/she is already in receipt of any scholarship/fellowship awarded by the University of Delhi or any other University or the Central Government or any State Government or a Private body other than a free-ship or financial aid. If the student with the highest marks is already in receipt of another scholarship/fellowship the award will go to the student with the next highest marks in the first year M.Sc. examination among the student opting for Organic Chemistry.
5. In case the awardee under this endowment is awarded any other scholarship/fellowship from any other source he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account from the date he/she was awarded any other scholarship/fellowship
6. In case a scholar discontinues his/her studies without valid reasons, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on account of the fellowship.
7. The payment of the fellowship amount shall be made to the scholar through the Head of the Department of Chemistry on presentation of a bill and a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill the awardee was not in receipt of any other scholarship from any other source.
8. Any amount accruing as interest from the endowment and not spent shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
9. A report of the award of fellowship shall be furnished to the donor or a legal heir at a time. The legal heir in this case is Shri Vivek Jain.

4. In case, the student securing the highest marks in the M.Sc. (Previous) Examination as above is in receipt of any other scholarship as provided hereafter, the scholarship will be awarded to the next eligible satisfying the above conditions.
5. Any student in receipt of this scholarship shall not be permitted to hold any other scholarship/financial assistance, awarded by Delhi University or any other University or by the Central Government or state Government or Private Body, except fresship.
6. The scholarship shall be awarded for a period of one year and shall be subject to satisfactory progress of the student at studies.
7. Any amount accruing from interest of the endowment if not spent to during any year shall be added to the corpus of Endowment Fund.
8. A report of the award of the Scholarship shall be furnished to the Donors each time.

5. In case the awardee under this endowment is awarded any other scholarship or gets financial aid from any other source, he/she be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account from the date he/she was awarded any other scholarship or financial aid.
6. In case a scholar discontinues studies without valid reasons, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on account of the scholarship.

3. The scholarship shall be tenable for 12 months only from 1st May of a year to 30th April, of the next year.
4. No student shall be eligible for the award of this scholarship if he or she already in receipt of a scholarship awarded by the University of Delhi or any other University or the Central Government or any State Government or a Private Body other than scholarship or financial aid.
5. In case the awardee under this endowment is awarded any other scholarship or gets financial aid from any other source, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account from the date he/she was awarded any other scholarship or financial aid.
6. In case a scholar discontinues studies without valid reasons, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on account of the scholarship.
7. (Final) Chemistry payable out of the interest accruing on the endowment fund of Rs.2,00,000/- donated by Ms. Kamini Bajaj and Swadesh Chadha, 65, South Park Apartment, B-Block, Kalkaji, New Delhi-110019 in memory of their uncle late Prof. Vishwamitter Khanna.
  2. The scholarship shall be of the value of Rs.1,100/- per month (or the accrued income of the endowment fund during the year, whichever is less) tenable for one year and shall be awarded every year to a deserving student of M.Sc. (Final) year in the Department of Chemistry of the University on the recommendation of the committee consisting of the following:
    1. Head of the Department of Chemistry.
    2. Two senior Professors of the Department.
  3. No student shall be eligible for the award of the scholarship if he/she already holds a scholarship awarded by Delhi University or any other University or the Central Government or any State Government or Private Body, other than freeship.
  4. In case any scholar accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account from the date he/she accepts the other scholarship/financial assistance.
  5. In case a scholar discontinues the studies without valid reasons, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on account of the scholarship.
  6. The payment of the scholarship amount shall be made to the scholar through the Principal of the College/Head of the Department from May each year on presentation of a bill and a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill, the scholar was not in receipt of any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source.
  7. The unutilized amount in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
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112. Prof. K.N. Johri Memorial Scholarships

1. There shall be two Postgraduate scholarships called 'Prof. K.N. Johri Memorial Scholarships' for the students of M.Sc.(Chemistry) offering Inorganic Chemistry as specialization, payable out of the interest earned by the endowment of Rs.5 lac made by Mr. Rajive Johri.
2. The scholarships shall be of the value of Rs.1000/- pm each tenable for one year and shall be awarded every year to one male and one female student of M.Sc. (Chemistry) final year class, who secure the highest marks in the M.Sc.(P) examination in the University of Delhi. The scholarships shall be awarded strictly by merit.
3. In case the student(s) securing the highest marks in the M.Sc.(P) examination as above is/are in receipt of any other scholarships, the scholarships will be awarded to the next eligible candidate satisfying the above criteria.
4. The payment of these scholarships will be made to the students through the Head, Department of Chemistry on presenting a certificate/undertaking to the effect that the students were not in receipt of any other scholarship or financial assistance from any other source during the period.
5. Any amount of interest accrued from the endowment and not spent in any year shall be added to the corpus fund.

**“THE JEAN AND ASHIT GANGULY EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP”**

1. The donation will be placed in the name “**The Jean and Ashit Ganguly Education Fund**” created for the purpose of award of scholarships for students of Delhi University.
2. The Scholarship will be awarded out of the annual interest that accrues from the appropriate investment of the capital (Corpus). Any balance amount of the annual interest will be added up to the capital and the donors will decide on the increase in the number of the fellowships at a future date.
3. The total numbers of awards for M.Sc. students will be determined every year depending upon the income that accrues on the endowment fund in a particular year. After determining the total number of awards available in a particular year the same shall be notified to the Department of Chemistry and the ACBR in ratio of 3:1 respectively. The award shall be renewed for the final year on satisfactory performance of the previous year. The sponsor may suggest redistribution or an increase in number of awards at any future date for implementation by the University.
4. The selection of the scholars should be based on academic merits, with an additional consideration of the financial needs of the students in the selection process.

6. As and when the CSIR revised the award amount for their awardees a revision may be made out of the “Jean and Ashit Ganguly Education Scholarship” also to a parallel extent in order to retain meritorious students. The awardees will submit a half yearly report on his/her work for the concerned year to the heads of the respective institution for evaluation by an appropriate method.
  7. A brief summary of the details of the annual awards be send to the sponsors for their record.

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## NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Outstanding graduates in Humanities, Social Sciences and Sciences shall be eligible for the award provided they undertake their postgraduate studies as full time students in a University Department recognised by the University Grants Commission as a Centre of Advanced Study/Department of Special Assistance.
2. With a view to encouraging meritorious students from other Universities to continue their studies at CAS/DSA the scholarships allocated to each centre have been grouped as (a) External, to be awarded to students having their B.A./B.Sc./ or Honours degree from a University other than the one in which the CAS/DSA is located, and (b) internal, for students of the same University in which the CAS/DSA are located respectively. 50% of scholarships of CAS/DSA are to be awarded to external candidates i.e. to persons who have done B.A./B.Sc. from other Universities.
3. Value of the Scholarships
  - i. The Value of each scholarship is Rs.250/- per month in addition a sum of Rs.400/- for the duration of the course, payable in instalment of Rs.200/- each year for the purchase of books.
  - ii. Actual second class rail fare, once each way for journey from the place of residence to the CAS/DSA and back, for students coming from other Universities to the CAS/DSA and
  - iii. A sum of Rs.100/- as incidental expenses will be paid by the University Grants Commission.
4. Duration

The scholarships shall be tenable for the Masters' Degree course, upto a maximum of two academic years including the vacation period in the CAS/DSA recognised by the University Grants Commission.
5. The scholar shall not draw any stipend or emolument from any other source during the tenure of the award or relinquish the award made to him/her before the expiry of two years.
6. If it should appear at any time to the commission that the progress or conduct of a scholar has not been satisfactory, the scholarship may be suspended or withdrawn.
7. Application for award

Selection of candidates for the award be finalised by 31<sup>st</sup> August each year. In no case would the awards be made with retrospective effect.
9. The award will be effective from the date of scholar joins the course or the commencement of the academic session whichever is later.
