

**Guidelines for the award of Jawahar Bhawan Trust-Merit-Cum-Means**

**Scholarships:-**

1. Post Graduate scholarships not exceeding ten in number will be awarded each year from the academic session 1999-2000 in the Faculties of Arts, Social Sciences, Applied/Basic Science, Bio-Medical Research Centre, Institute of Informatics and Communication to students of M.A./M.Sc.(Final) year @Rs.1000/- p.m.

2. The distribution of scholarships will be in the following manner:-

(a) Faculty of Arts	-	2
(b) Faculty of Social Sciences	-	2
(c) Bio-medical Research Centre	-	2
(d) Institute of Informatics and Communication	-	2
(e) Faculty of Science	-	1
(f) Faculty of Inter Disciplinary and Applied Sciences	-	$\frac{1}{10}$

3. The scholarship will be awarded to only those Departments/Centres/Institutes which come under the maintenance budget of the University and for conventional masters' programme (list enclose).

4. The scholarship in the Faculties of Science/Applied Science/Social Sciences and Arts will be given to only two Departments for one year and it would rotate to next Departments in order of seniority (similar to Deanship) but instead of three years, it will be for one year.

5. Scholarships would be given to students on merit-cum-means basis only, i.e. the criteria for the award would be merit-cum-means only (whose parents income including his/her own income does not exceed to the amount from it starts attracting income tax.). The required funds would be released by the Jawahar Bhawan Trust for one year on receipt of demand in anticipation to the selection of students.

6. No distinction or discrimination will be made on the basis of caste, creed, community, religion or sex.

7. The scheme will be known as JAWAHAR BHAWAN TRUST MERIT-CUM-MEANS SCHOLARSHIP.

8. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council of the University on the recommendations of the Selection Committee consisting of the following:-

1. The Dean, Faculty concerned.
2. Head of the Department concerned/Director of the Centre/Institute.

9. Two senior teachers of the Department/Centre/Institute concerned (to be nominated by the Head of the Department.)

10. No student, who is in receipt of this scholarship, shall accept any other scholarship/financial assistance, from any other source. In case he/she accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from and other source, the total amount received by him/her from this scholarship shall be refunded to the University from the date he/she accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance.

If it should appear at any time that a scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross-misconduct or has been very irregular in attendance, he/she shall, after due warning in writing, be reported by the Head of the Department/Dean of the Faculty concerned to the Academic Council who may reduce, suspend or withdraw his/her scholarship.
