

' THE WATUMULL FOUNDATION (INDIA) POST GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP'

1. There shall be a scholarship known as 'The Watumull Foundation (India) Post-Graduate Scholarship' to be awarded out of the annual income accruing from the endowment fund of Rs. 12,000/- endowed by Watumull Foundation (India) Delestar, 1st Floor, 9-9A, Hughes Road, Bombay-36 W.B.
2. A Scholarship of Rs. 100/- p.m. tenable for 2 years of the duration of course shall be awarded to a poor and needy student who joins the 1st year of Post-Graduate Course in Physics/Chemistry/Botany/Zoology/Anthropology/Geology/Commerce of this University, provided the student concerned is a regular student of the University and had secured not less than 60% marks in the previous examination and whose parents income including his/her own income does not exceed Rs. 25,000/- per annum excluding permissible standard deductions.
3. The Scholarship for the award shall be announced every alternate year or after a gap of two years, as the case may be, through the Principals/Heads of the Colleges/Departments.
4. No student shall be eligible for this scholarship if he/she is in receipt of any scholarship or any other financial assistance, other than freeship, from any University/State Government/Private Body and the Central Government.
5. In case a scholar accepts any other scholarship or financial assistance from any other source, the total amount received from this endowment fund shall be refunded by him/her to the University from the date he/she accepts any other scholarship or financial assistance. The unutilized amount will be added to the corpus fund.
6. If it appears to the University at any time that a scholar is unable to show satisfactory progress or is found guilty towards his/her conduct or is irregular in attendance, he/she shall, after due warning in writing be reported by Head of the Department/Institution to the Academic Council, who may withdraw the Scholarship.
7. Each application for the scholarship, in the prescribed form obtainable from the office of the Registrar, must reach the Registrar, University of Delhi, Delhi-7, through the Principal/Head of the College/Departments by the date mentioned in the notification issued in this behalf, together with a certificate from the Principal/Head of the College/Department to the effect that the applicant is a poor, needy and deserving student for the award and that the income of his/her parent/guardian does not exceed Rs. 25,000/- per annum excluding permissible standard deductions.
8. The Scholarship amount shall be payable monthly by the Registrar, on a bill through the Principal/Head of the Institution who shall certify thereon that the scholar is in regular attendance, that his conduct is good and that his progress is satisfactory.
9. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendations of the Selection Committee constituted as follows:-
  1. The Dean, Faculty of Science (Chairman)
  2. The Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences
  3. The Heads of the concerned Departments.
